

MOBILE PHONES

You may have seen more articles in the media over the summer about the use of mobile phones in schools and many schools have now banned them altogether. We are continuing with our policy from last year, which we believe supports the safety of students while ensuring the focus is on learning. To this end, students may bring phones to school but they must be switched off/on silent from 0850 until 1510 and kept away in bags. If a mobile is seen or used without the permission of a member of staff (for use as a calculator, for example), it will be confiscated and locked away in Reception. Parents/carers will then receive a phone call asking them to collect the phone at their convenience. I appreciate your support in reinforcing this with your child, as this will only be of benefit to their learning and well being. As always, a child needing to contact home during the school day should do so by reporting to their Year Leader or to reception and they will be allowed to use the school phone.
